



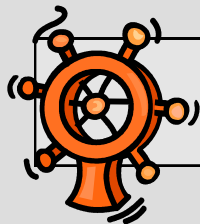

Ulrich brought out his working aeroplane engine - completely handmade right down to the piston rings. He ran it a few times both days and it certainly added to the displays.

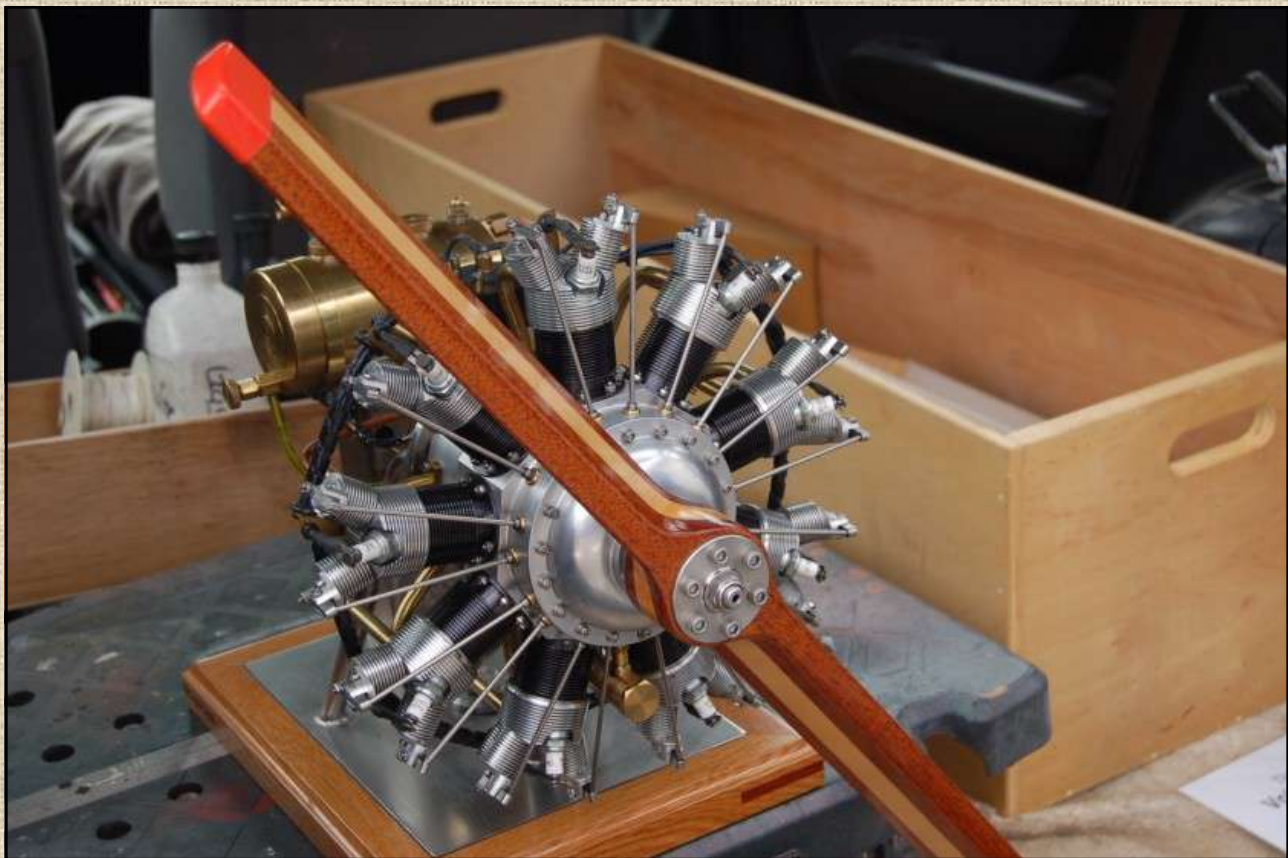
End of Sunday they announced the results of the voting:
