


June 25th 1989. West Coast Model Boat Club regatta...Vanier Park.

1. Best of Master.

3 Intermediate.

Three prizes.

This class is for those who have entered a contest or regatta before but have never won a prize.

4 Novice

Three prizes.


This class is for those who have never entered a contest or regatta before.

There will also be a Judges' choice award and a Modellers' choice award. One prize for each.

For those of you coming from the Swartz Bay Ferry, travel south on the Pat Bay Highway for approx 15 kilometres then turn left onto Island View Rd and then left again onto Lochside Dr.

You will pass the Grounds of the Historical Society on your left just before you get to Island View Rd.

For those of you coming from Victoria, travel north on the Pat Bay Hwy (Hwy17) for approximately 18 kilometres and turn right onto Island View Rd the left onto Lochside Dr.




From the Editor.
