



CRADLE FOR EAST COAST 12m.

Thanks to Rod Carr and U.S. Boat and Ship Modeler magazine for this pattern.

The hull should sit with its full weight on the bottom of the keel with the cradle ends used to merely keep the hull upright. Use 1/2 to 3/4 inch wood or plywood. Note that the ends are inset where they contact the bottom piece as shown in the side view.

You might wish to increase the height of the ends so as to allow a drawer beneath the boat which can hold your transmitter, spare batteries and a few tools. Pad the bottom and ends of the cradle with carpet. Lengths of rope serve as a convenient handles and allow the boat to be carried with one hand. GOOD LUCK.

I would like to warm people using a product called <u>Testor's Dullcaat</u> of a potential problem that I have experienced. I used this product in many areas on the Lady Rose to simulate the dull apearance that a salt water ship attains after a few months at sea. The problem is that scince I completed the model two or three years ago the <u>Dullcoat</u> is flaking off, and as it does this it makes the model appear to be badly finished. There is oviously somthing wrong with this product because it was applied over Testor's black paint, so the products should be compatable. Once all of the <u>Dullcoat</u> has flaked off there will be no problem, but until this occurs the model will appear to be a mess. Any possible solutions?
