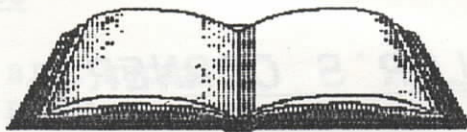

THE HERRING CATCH FRENZY

This 'frenzy' has been with us as far back as the seventeenth century. Fishing 'luggers' would begin the season at the Shetland Islands and continue down the coast following the herring. The catch would be run ashore to be cleaned, salted and packed in barrels by women. With no refrigeration, the process was done at great speed and a three-woman crew would clean, salt and pack thirty barrels in a day, each barrel contained seven hundred herring.

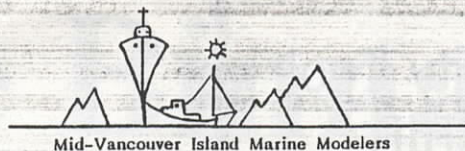

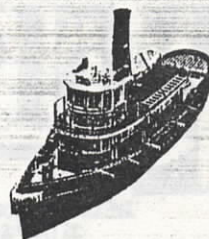
