#### ELECTRONICS FOR MODEL BOATERS

OK guys, here's this months project - a deep sounding air horn or fog horn. It operates on a 9 volt battery and is very economical to build. All parts are available at Radio Shack.

TR 1 & TR 2 form a stabdard multivibrator oscillator the output of which is fed into TR 3 where it is amplified a little and then passed by VR 1 into an audio amplifier chip - the LM 386 and then to the loudspeaker.

Here's a reminder for the transistors...




A - COLCECTOR - A

B - Don't foget all capacitors with a + or 
B - BASE

C - EMMITTER - correctly.


BOTTOM VIEW

By increasing the size of the two ceramic disc capacitors (C 1 & C 2) the tone will get deeper. By adding a 1000 mfd/16 V electrolitic capacitor across the circuit (as shown below) the sound will taper off like a fog horn.


